# An Educational Partnership between Fordham University and BronxWorks, Sponsored by the Teagle Foundation

The *Fordham History Makers Scholars Program* was created in collaboration between Fordham University and BronxWorks. Sponsored by The Teagle Foundation, the program which was created in 2006, aims to support local high school students by challenging them to strive for academic excellence. The program seeks to achieve these goals through an intensive five-week summer academic course located on Fordham University's Rose Hill Campus.

The History Makers Scholars Program (HMP) is a five-week summer enrichment program which encourages and challenges High School students to complete college level academic work while allowing participants to engage themselves as college students on a daily basis. The Program seeks to excite and expose students to history beyond the textbook. Through this program, students will spend time on campus, explore various historical sites throughout New York City, meet and converse with college professors, college students, administrators and faculty. Through the History Makers program students develop research projects; prepare presentations, practice writing skills and complete college level reading assignments.

The content of the program focuses upon the history of New York City with a special emphasis on the Bronx. The program introduces history to be studied in a different format, which is often taught in the classroom. Participants will develop critical thinking skills and will examine events and experiences through diverse perspectives. History Maker participants research facts and knowledge often ignored and left out of mainstream history. Student's completed research and work will culminate into a final presentation, presented in front of program staff, Fordham University professors, agency officials, friends, family and special invited guests.

#### **College Access**

In 2009 the Program expanded, enhancing the services provided to the students and maintaining the continued exposure for students in all aspects of college life.

During the academic year, Scholars will have the opportunity to return to Fordham's campus for a series called *College Access*, workshops, networking events, college shadowing days and support from college mentors. This sustained exposure will serve to enhance students' knowledge and access to college campuses, build relationships with college students, faculty, and staff, as well as support them as they navigate the college search. Additionally BronxWorks CAFE program provides additional college preparatory services, college management assistance, and individual counseling on all aspects of the college selection and application process.
